


Special Instructions: Customizing an Assignment


To help guide students as they revise, MY Access! provides you with a distinct field to add your grading criteria, additional guidance, supplemental materials, URLs, graphics, files or other information.

Step 6: "Add Tools" of the Assignment Wizard > scroll to **Special Instructions**



To add a file from your computer or hyperlink a web document



Graphics can also be added in the same way by choosing the Graphic icon



Sample Special Instructions

Your essay will be graded, based on completing the following:

- Strong introduction, with your claim, highlighted in green.
- Three or more body paragraphs, each beginning with a strong argument as the topic. sentence, with a minimum of 2 cited references in each paragraph.
- One strong counterargument in each paragraph.
- Strong transitions at the beginning of each paragraph and within, when noting references.
- Strong conclusion, with the claim as the first sentence.


